Ongoing Volunteer Opportunities at the MFC

Youth Tutors: Positive adult male and female role models are needed to help with homework during a one-on-one session (1 hour) with youth in grades k-8th. Tutors will help youth with homework, work on literacy skills, and participating in educational activities with the youth. This is 1 hour a week commitment. This could be once a week or twice a week depending on the availability of tutor. Match would need to be between 3:00-7:00pm M-F. Tutors are needed for upper-level math, science, and foreign language. Ideally, candidates will have some prior tutoring experience. Hours are flexible; opportunities vary based on the needs of student and availability of tutor. [Multiple positions available](#)

2ND LANGUAGE TUTORS NEEDED

Is English your second language and/or are you fluent in another language such as Spanish, French, German or Mandarin (Chinese)? Consider becoming a volunteer tutor to assist elementary, middle and high school students. Positive adult male and female role models needed to tutor students one-on-one to help with homework and increase language skills. A minimum of 1 hour/week commitment for the entire school year is preferred, however, one school semester is acceptable. If interested in becoming a tutor, please contact the MFC. Teen Night Assistants: Positive male and female role models needed! Volunteers are needed to assist with teen programming on Wednesday nights from 4-7:30 pm. This will include weekly meetings, facilitating discussions, preparing food, preparing for and facilitating the Teen Advisory Panel, and assisting with field trips (**all volunteers are required to attend one social outing**). Must have high expectations for youth behavior and be willing and able to enforce policies. This program runs through the school year. [3 positions available](#)

Computer for Communities Program: Volunteer is needed to help load software onto formatted, donated computers and update training manual as needed. This person would also help with outreach to community businesses and individuals to collect more computers for the program. Hours are varied and depend on availability of computers from the City and other partners. [2 positions open, as needed](#)

Special Events and Programs Assistants: If you want to volunteer, but can't commit to a set schedule this may be an option for you. We have plenty of special events for holidays and cultural events that we need extra volunteers to assist with these one-time events. This is also a great chance for families to volunteer together! MFC Food Pantry Volunteers:

Volunteering takes place during the third week of each month. We are looking for volunteers who can consistently offer their time at least every other month doing one or more of the following tasks:

- Shop for food at St. Stephen's Food Bank and transport food to the MFC during one or more of the following times: Monday 8am-4pm, Tuesday 8am-4pm, Wednesday 8-11am.
- Sort and box food pantry items from 5:30-8:00pm on the 3rd Thursday of the month.
- Help carry food pantry items for families during our program (3rd Friday monthly from 1:30-5:00pm).
- Carry up to 30 pounds.
- Provide and drive a vehicle (mileage will be reimbursed).
